- **Parking:** Be aware that buses and cars can shortly drop the guests in front of the building, but no parking can be guaranteed at the venue.

Commemoration Ceremony of the European Roma Holocaust Memorial Day

- Date: 2 August from 11.00 until 13.00
- Venue: Roma and Sinti Memorial in Blle, Auschwitz-Birkenau State Museum
- Wreath Laying Ceremony and Flowers: Please <u>inform the organizers</u> if you plan to lay a wreath during ceremony; the ceremony will follow a protocol decided by the organizers.
 Wreaths should be delivered by 9.00-9.30 AM to the Info Point at the entrance to BIIe. Please contact us if you need help to arrange a wreath.
- Parking
 - Parking 1: The road leading directly to the entrance of section BIIe is reserved
 exclusively for the buses and cars of Holocaust survivors, elderly people and
 political/diplomatic representations. Drivers are requested to send the license plate
 number to the organizers: <u>jonathan.mack@sintiundroma.de</u>. Security staff will only
 allow registered cars to enter.
 - Parking 2: There is an additional parking lot <u>next to the church</u>, before entering the secured area and parking 1.
 - Parking 3: Group buses are requested to park at the communal parking lot,
 Czernichowska 57, 32-600 Brzezinka. We recommend the arrival until 9.30 AM, as it is a 20-30 min walk to the commemoration place, and groups need to pass security.
- **Entrance Time**: Guests are invited to enter the area BIIe and to walk to the Roma and Sinti memorial from 9.45 until 10.30 AM, delegations of survivors and VIP representatives are expected at 10.30 AM.



- Arrival and Security: The entrance to the commemoration site will be restricted, participants
 should arrive early enough to pass the security at the entrance. Please adhere to instructions
 of the Museum Security, guides and employees of the Museum, as well as of volunteers of
 the commemoration ceremony. The Museum Security recommends that guests do not bring
 bags that are bigger than a A4 paper.
- **Registration**: All guests of the commemoration ceremony are kindly asked to confirm their attendance through the online form or to communicate directly with the organizers.
- **Support for Elderly People**: Electric cars are available at the entrance of BIIe for those who cannot walk to the Roma and Sinti Memorial. Priority attention is given to the survivors and elderly people.
- Languages during the Ceremony: simultaneous translations are available in English, Polish, Romani and German
- Media staff: Journalists are requested to confirm their attendance before the event, and to
 meet the organizer's media team at the Info Point at the entrance on Blle. Interview requests

- **Free entrance passes**: Please contact the organizers (before or on the spot) if you are interested in free entrance passes to the Auschwitz Museum.
- Venue: Enter through the regular visitor entrance (<u>Main entrance of the Auschwitz Museum</u>, entrance from the street side: Stanisławy Leszczyńskiej).
 <u>Attention</u>: No bags bigger than the size of A4 paper can enter through the security check; in case you can lock your bags at the Museum's visitor centre.
